The children of OLSP have a clear idea of how adults should behave at our school. We therefore ask that if you are a staff member, a visitor, or a volunteer, you abide by this code of conduct:

The children ask you to be:

- Funny (with a good sense of humour)
 - Kind and always smiling
 - Brave
 - Guide us
 - Help us when we're sad
- Fair, respectful and a good attitude
 - A good friend
- Excited to be here, happy if your teaching and enthusiastic
 - Playful e.g. joining in games when outside
- Peaceful, calm and calming when things are tough. Never shouting we are a no shouting school.
 - Friendly and keep us safe
 - Ready for the class
 - Creative
 - Thoughtful and supportive inclusive of our charity work
 - Positive and turn negatives into positives
 - Follow rules and be strict when needed, but not too!
 - Rewards positive behaviours
 - Never angry and don't tell off in front of others
 - Challenge everyone and support if we don't understand
- Listen well to all points of view and opinions and try to problem solve together
 - Forgiving and helpful
 - Good listener
 - Inclusive
 - Join us in our quest for being healthy (in all ways)
 - Tidy and not wasteful with resources

This policy is to be reviewed annually by OLSP children. Last reviewed March 2025
