

Please read on to find out about all the new and exciting learning we will be immersing ourselves over this half term.
Homework	Homework is posted on a Monday and a spelling test will be on the following Monday  English: Weekly spellings are set each Monday. Each week, the children receive a list of at least 10 words which will focus on practising new spelling rules. The spellings will be uploaded on Class Dojo and a copy will be sent home for the children to practise.  → Weekly spelling tests take place on Fridays. → Please make sure regular practice takes place. → Maths: Children can continue to use Times-table Rockstars as well as other times-table links whichever your child prefers.  If your TTRS login does not work, please do let me know and I will be able to reset this for you.  I am more than happy to provide any times-table resources which can be sent home, please do just ask.
English	'Our Tower' by Joseph Coleho is a story which follows three children living in a tower block, as they embark on a fantastical adventure which helps them see their home in a new light.  The aim of the scheme of learning will be for pupils to write a journal from a point of a view as one of the characters in the story.

	PE	For PE, the children will be participating in a range of different exercises which may be conducted in a circuit. The children will be learning about how to correctly do different exercises and how this can work our bodies.
		The children will also be learning gymnastics on a Tuesday afternoon.  The children will be doing a range of different stretches, jumps and rolls across the gymnastics curriculum.

	MFL (Y3+)	In Spanish, the children will be taken by Mrs Emmerton on a Friday afternoon where they will be continuing their Spanish learning

		journey. Pupils will be learning about different types of fruit and about how to include this language in simple conversation techniques.
	Computing	For computing, the children will be mentored by Mr Hopkins on a Friday afternoon about how to programme and perform different tasks on Scratch. I am sure many children in the class will be looking forward to this.
