
## Our Lady and St Patrick's RC Primary School

Please make sure they are returned so they can be exchanged for new ones.  Literacy  The children will be focussing on sentence structure using techniques like hold a sentence and write a sentence. We will also be looking at the correct use of capital letters and full stops in our writing.  The children will be looking at shape (composing and decomposing shapes) volume and capacity, sorting and time. The Nursery children will be continuing with the NCETM Number blocks programme.  Our focus in RE this half term we will be taking a closer look at the lives of Peter and Paul and learning about their importance. We will also have some special visitors in school to teach us about their religion and observe their transition to butterflies. We will also be looking at the life cycles of animals.
